

SMALL CELL LUNG CANCER CASE

The following is a summary of a report received from Roxanne Newman on October 23, 1998.

Roxanne Newman had small cell lung cancer involvement.

Prognosis: Life expectancy without treatment (chemotherapy & radiation) was 2-4 months

Life expectancy with treatment (chemotherapy & radiation) was 12-14 months

Roxanne Newman started taking the Haelan 951, Platinum Formula at the rate of one bottle per day (4 oz. AM plus 4 oz. PM) throughout the time period she received her chemotherapy (Cisplatin and VP 16) and radiation treatments. She received 30 radiation treatments to the chest area in addition to 15 radiation treatments to the brain area.

Chemotherapy (Cisplatin and VP16) was administered for three consecutive days followed by a lapse of three weeks before the next round of chemotherapy was administered. In total, six sets of chemotherapy (3 days per set) was administered every three weeks starting in April, 1998.

Three weeks after Roxanne began taking the Haelan along with the first three sets of chemotherapy treatments (3 in number over a three week period) she was tested:

Expected results from chemotherapy - 10% tumor shrinkage

Results attained with Haelan and chemotherapy: - 95% tumor shrinkage

After receiving the second set of 3 chemotherapy treatments administered over the following three week period Roxanne Newman was tested again.

Results attained from the use of Haelan and chemotherapy 100% shrinkage

Roxanne Newman was then scanned to determine if there were any cancer cells in her body and the results showed her to be completely cancer free.

Side effects during treatment were minimal while Roxanne Newman took the Haelan 951 oral nutritional product. Roxanne did not have any visible signs of the chemotherapy treatment and her friends were not able to detect that she was receiving chemotherapy. Again, Haelan's Platinum Formula 951 has demonstrated it's ability to offset the toxic side effects of chemotherapy and radiotherapy treatments. This report reinforces the need for those with cancer to properly access the need for adjuvant nutrition while they receive medical treatments.
